

CORE LNGas hive participated at the TEN-T Days organised by the European Commission in Ljubljana, Slovenia 25-27th April

CORE LNGas hive participated at the Trans-European Transport Network (TEN-T) days in Ljubljana, with other 2000 participants, among them 26 ministers of transport (one of them Spanish Ministry Iñigo de la Serna), Members of the European Parliament and key stakeholders. The TEN T-Days agenda was around how to contribute to smart, sustainable and safe Mobility, relying on the trans-European transport network and investments in transport connectivity.

There were high-level Interinstitutional meetings to discuss further synergies between transport, energy and digital connectivity, and the investment support with highest EU value-added in the post-2020 framework, with the approval of the Ljubljana declaration at the end by all relevant stakeholders on key principles for investment in smart, sustainable and safe mobility. At the same time other high-level events took place, such as the Ministerial session with Southern Mediterranean countries. The TEN-T Days also hosted an idea accelerator and futuristic lab that allowed young European entrepreneurs and companies to showcase innovative mobility solutions.

In addition, there was an exhibition of around 100 co-funded transport projects at the venue. CORE LNGas hive shared its aims with the participants on Thursday 26th and participated also in the exhibition with a stand at the disposal of interested stakeholders sharing information and videos about the initiative that is developing a safe, efficient and integrated logistics chain for the supply of LNG as a more sustainable fuel for the maritime sector. It was a perfect opportunity for Project coordinator Fernando Impuesto and Technical Leader Jose Enrique Murcia, to interact with several stakeholders and representatives of the European Commission, including European Commissioner for Transport Violeta Bulc and Spanish Ministry of Public Works and Transport, Iñigo de la Serna and other representatives at the Trans-European Transport Network from the Ministry, María del Corral and Rosa Izquierdo.
