

## REPSOL HITS RECORD COMPLETING ANOTHER MEGA TRUCK-TO-SHIP LNG BUNKERING SUPPLY IN SPAIN

Repsol has completed its largest LNG bunkering supply operation, supplying the Canadian vessel with 470 m<sup>3</sup> of LNG from eleven trucks in Cartagena (Spain).

Repsol has achieved another goal consolidating its position as LNG bunker spot supplier. Developing the LNG bunker business, both on a spot and mid/long term basis, is one of the key parts of Repsol's strategy to provide multiple client solutions, adding LNG to its portfolio of bunker fuels.

Repsol coordinated and managed the LNG bunkering operation in collaboration with Enagás, ESK and the Port Authority of Cartagena. The previous record operation had been the supply of 425m<sup>3</sup> of LNG to the *Mia Desgagnés*.

The *Paul A. Desgagnés* vessel is the third of a series of four product carriers built at the Besiktas shipyard. Its most notable feature is that it can operate using any of three types of fuel: fuel oil, marine diesel oil or LNG.
